

Instructions for Non-Federal Personnel Accessing the US EPA Inspector Wiki & Inspector Training

The Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Inspector Wiki provides federal, tribal, state, local inspectors with comprehensive inspector-related information and training.

Visit the Inspector Wiki for:

- EPA inspection policies and requirements
- Program-specific resources arranged by statute
- Resources to support pre-, during- and post-inspection activities
- EPA points of contact

Non-Federal personnel must create a **Login.gov** account before accessing the Inspector Wiki for the first time. Resources are available the help create a login.gov account:

- You will receive an email from *wam_support@epa.gov* once your Inspector Wiki access request has been approved.

Inspector training is available through EPA’s Learning Management System, **FedTalent**.

Non-Federal personnel need a FedTalent account to take inspector eLearning training.

 - ❖ DO NOT request a FedTalent account through Login.gov
